

[Original Saratoga potato chips reintroduced by local company](#)

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A familiar part of local lore is that the potato chip was invented at Moon's Lake House in Saratoga Springs in 1853, and Moon Brand Original Saratoga Chips were sold throughout New England until the 1920s. A pair of business partners, Dan Jameson and Paul Tator, have recreated the product and are selling it in boxes (example below) modeled after an original box they found at the Saratoga Springs History Museum in the Canfield Casino. The chips were introduced at the museum earlier this month.

With a suggested retail price of \$1.49 for a 1.5-ounce individual serving and \$4.49 for a 9-ounce family size, the new Moon Brand Original Saratoga Chips are available at dozens of locations in and around Saratoga Springs, including the Hannaford supermarket on Weibel Avenue.
